center for our charitable giving this holiday season.







Hold the Date! Friday, 1.26.24 from 1:00 – 2:00ish! Winter doesn't mean we have to cover up our green thumbs! In January, we will be attending an in-store, hands-on workshop at Telly's Greenhouse where we will learn how to create a Succulent Dish Garden of our choice. One of Telly's Specialists will walk us through how to choose our dish garden, and the succulents that will go in our vessel, as well as give us tips on putting it together and how to care for them. The cost for the workshop starts at \$35 (includes vessel and succulents) but from there you will have complete control of upgrading to a different dish garden and add as many succulents as your pocketbook will allow. If you have a favorite vessel and want to bring it to the class, you will only be charged for the succulents and a small class fee.


