The activity rooms were full of apparatus to engage the children (1 to 12 years old) in their verbal, physical, musical, social, etc. development. We asked about the decorations as the children are blind but Janet, our Community Relations tour guide, explained that the children's siblings/parents/cousins/visitors are not blind and when the visitors get excited and describe the wonderful rooms to the children that then the children get excited too. 
Bowling – Darcel Connors, Secretary

As every mah jongg player knows, the new year really doesn't arrive until April when the new card comes out! It's finally here!!!


