A few things happening in 2019

This program provides dog or cat food at no charge to owned pets in an effort to keep animals in their current homes. The MHS Pet Pantry drive will be throughout the month of November. In the meantime, if everyone could start stocking up on small bags (only) of dog and cat food as well as wet puppy and kitten food it will ensure the food drive to be a great success.
